**For all applicants, both internal and external, the minimum entry requirement is:**

At least 5 grade 6's at GCSE (B grades if reformed GCSEs have not been sat).

At least grade 5 or above in English Language and Mathematics, if these subjects are not being taken in the Sixth Form (or C grades if reformed GCSEs have not been sat).

Grade 7 for Mathematics and Science (or A grades if reformed GCSEs have not been sat ) if these subject are to be studied at A Level.

Grade 6 (or B grades if reformed GCSEs have not been sat) at GCSE in all other subjects studied at A Level. For subjects not previously studied at GCSE, a grade 6 or higher is required in an equivalent subject (please see Sixth Form Courses pages for further information).

It is possible to study some new subjects at A Level that you may not have encountered at GCSE; their entry requirements are given below.

**Entry requirements for subjects not taken at GCSE:**

**Classics** – at least a grade 6 (or grade B if reformed GCSEs have not been taken) in English Language and Literature and at least a B grade in History if studied at GCSE.

**Psychology** - at least a grade 6 (or grade B if reformed GCSEs have not been taken) in English Language and Mathematics and a B grade in Additional Science (or Biology if studied as separate science).

**Business Studies** - at least a grade 6 (or grade B if reformed GCSEs have not been taken) in English Language and Mathematics.

**Computer Studies** - at least a grade 6 (or grade B if reformed GCSEs have not been taken) in Mathematics.

**Geography** - at least a grade 6 (or grade B if reformed GCSEs have not been taken) in English Language and Mathematics.

**History** - at least a grade 6 (or grade B if reformed GCSEs have not been taken) in English Language and Literature.

**Economics** – at least a grade 6 (or grade B if reformed GCSEs have not been taken) in English Language and Mathematics.

*Please note that the subjects highlighted in **brown** will be taught at UCGS. Given above is an indication of which block these subjects appeared in for the school year 2017-18. At this point, it **cannot** be guaranteed that they will be offered by UCGS in the same blocks for 2018-2019, as their blocks are not finalised until later in the academic year. Should there be a change to that outlined above, those students affected will be advised and asked to reconsider their options in light of the changes.*

**Further Maths will be arranged to suit the timetables of the students concerned.**
